Human Interference (Urbanization and Industrialization):

adaptations have had to be rapid, cities are, in some respects, ideal laboratories for studying natural selection.

Ways to ameliorate the problems of interfering effects of urbanization and industrialization on insect, public health and environment

The very basic step that can be taken to reduce interfering effects of urbanization and industrialization with the

environment is creating awareness among people. The thoughtless exploitation (urbanization and industrialization) is mainly due to ignorance of man about the environment and ecosystem. So the basic step to be taken is to engage man in environmental education and show how important is the diversity of species in an ecosystem. This will entail:

1. Formal Environmental Education which includes teaching and training students at primary, secondary and higher levels and making them aware about the importance of conservation of environment. It also includes training of teachers and environmental professionals to create awareness among various sections of the society.

2. Non-Formal Environmental Education by educating the youth and adults from all sections of the society about environment through adult education programmes, by organizing Eco-development camps for the youth, spreading awareness by celebrating occasions like World Environment Day (5th June), NGOs conducting programmes like environmental education, conservation of nature aimed to reach out to various sections of the society.

The advocacy on the need to urbanize and industrialize our nation should not be at the detriment of the fauna and flora that were important in the conservation of the environment. This can be achieved with some definite actions such as judicious use of available resources, using Eco friendly products, trying to bring down all possible causes of environmental pollution, control of population growth. Although, this feat can't be achieved within a day or two but taking an initiative towards reducing the factors causing environmental degradation will militate the adverse impacts of un managed urbanization and industrialization on insect and other arthropod, public health and the environment.
